## VINTAGE MILITARY FUN MATCH

Here's a chance to enjoy shooting an as-issued vintage metallic-cartridge Military Rifle, or a faithful reproduction, from any nation. "Vintage" means the model was first issued between 1863 and 1950. The gun itself doesn't have to have been made then, but the model must have been first issued during that time. For example, M1 Garands and British Enfields were made until 1957 and guns made after 1950 are totally fine. Maybe it's an M1 Garand, 303 British Enfield, a 1903 or trapdoor Springfield, Mauser, Arisaka or another old war horse. Bring it out and put it through its paces! **All rifles must be in military conformation!** No sporterized rifles or scopes, **iron sights only.** The match is free but limited to 50 PPSA members.

This is an honor-system postal match where shooters complete a course of fire at any time during 6½-weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and mail targets to the match coordinator for scoring.

### COURSE OF FIRE

Targets are a 19-inch bullseye placed at 300 yards. Shooters will fire 20 rounds (5 prone, 5 sitting, 5 kneeling and 5 standing) at each of 2 targets for a total of 40 rounds.

### PRIZES

Prizes: First Place \$100 Gift Card

Second Place \$75 Gift Card

Third Place \$50 Gift Card

Also, everyone who is not a winner will be entered in a drawing for two \$50 Gift Cards.
